

Supporting the work of the Church

Thank you for your continued financial support for the church over the last few months, and for extra donations made in this time. It is good to see the doors of the church building open once more!

We are well aware that the use of cash has fallen in the last few months, in favour of electronic transactions - card and direct transfers.

If you want to make donations by cash or cheque, there will be envelopes available in the Narthex for these. Please leave them on the table by the card machine. These will be placed in the safe after the service and counted in due course.

However, we would prefer for the present that you donate electronically – by standing order, direct transfer, online donation or via the card reader. Depending on whether or not you can Gift Aid your donations, different options are preferable:-

If you do Gift Aid, Standing Order or electronic transfer are the best options, as well as online giving.

If you do not Gift Aid, using the card reader in the Narthex is the best option, as individual donations up to £30 made via this method can be included in the Gift Aid Small Donations Scheme, and the church can claim a top up of 25% from HMRC, whether or not you pay tax. We cannot claim this on cheques, standing orders, direct transfers or online donations.
